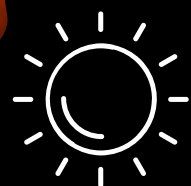

THE SUN

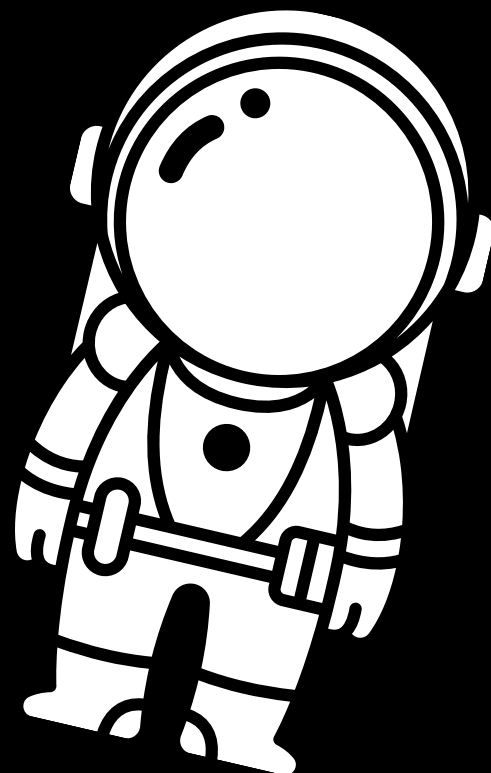

- No flash when taking photos.

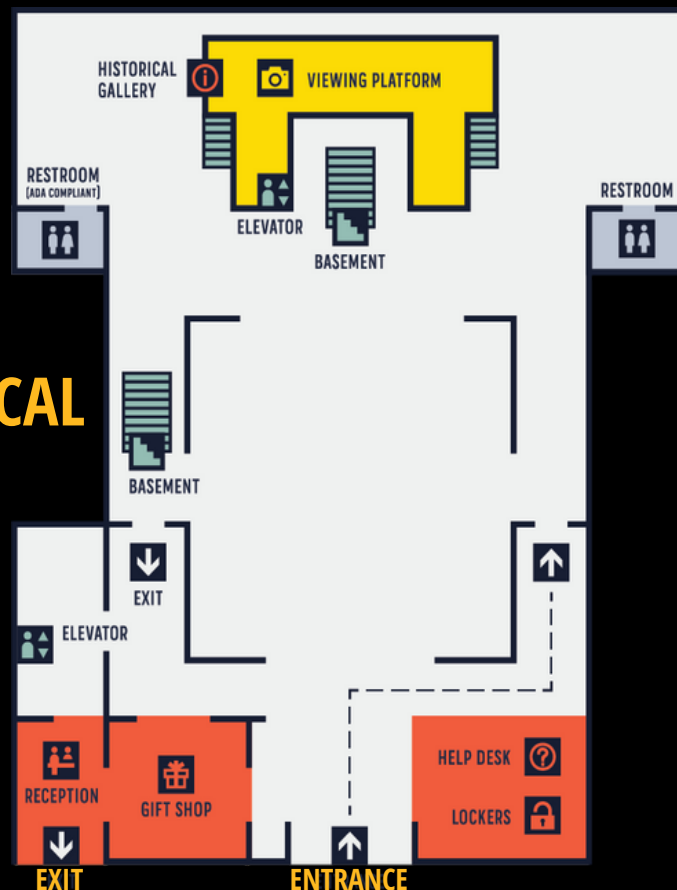

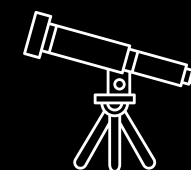
